
New Artist Exhibit: Chemistry + Nature = Art

A "Cyanotype" derives from an ancient photographic process that begins by painting a light-sensitive chemical solution onto paper. Once dry, a photogram is created when the paper, holding a natural object, is exposed to the sun.
