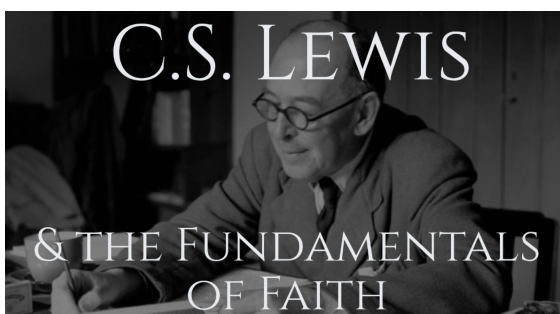
Men's Fellowship Breakfast **Saturday, February 8th | 8:00am | St. David's Hall**
