WORSHIP & MUSIC

We are a community who comes together to worship God on Sundays and at special services during the Church year. There are many opportunities for parishioner involvement in the worship and music ministries of St. David's. We encourage you to join us and offer your gifts to God.

Opportunities to *Serve & Grow...*

Altar Guild

Prepares the sanctuary for worship, and cares for the vessels, linens and vestments used in worship.

Flower Guild

Arranges flowers for the altar during our Sunday worship services and Holy Days.

Prayers of the People

Writers prepare the prayers for weekly services and special events.

Vergers

Assist the clergy during Sunday services. Training is provided and service is rotating.

Lay Assistants

Provide three kinds of liturgical leadership: reading the Word of the Lord (the lessons), offering the Prayers of the People (Intercessory prayers) & administering the chalice.

Acolytes (Gr. 5 and up)

Serve the clergy and congregation during services as crucifers, torchbearers, Gospel bearers and banner bearers.

Ushers

Offer hospitality to those who enter our doors, assist those needing to find a seat for worship and provide guidance at communion.

Sight and Sound Engineers

Assist with live streaming and tech during the Sunday service and other special services such as weddings or funerals.

St. David's *Music Ministry*

The Music Ministry at St. David's offers opportunities for children, youth, and adults (ages 3 and up) to become involved in the life of our parish through music. Through participation in our choir program, singers and ringers have the opportunity to grow in their faith, develop musical skills, work together in a group setting and provide musical leadership for the congregation.

The choirs and bell choirs rehearse weekly, lead worship on a regular basis, and participate in special services throughout the year. Many of our choirs are involved in community outreach and tour both regionally and internationally.

This year our vocal choirs will be meeting virtually and participating in virtual choirs. Our handbell choirs will be meeting to record for services in person.

Temporarily suspended during the pandemic.
Provided during worship and other special events that will benefit parents.

Primary Education | Pre-K-Grade 1 | 8:45-9:15am
Temporarily suspended during the pandemic.
Classes rotate through Godly Play (a Montessori-based curriculum), Arts & Crafts, Park Play & Story, with a snack and a music lesson.

Children's Sermon | Grade 5 & Younger | 9:15am
From September through May, during the 9:15 am service, children may access the prerecorded Children's Sermon. Visit the Livestream Service to find the link.

Elementary Education | Grade 2-5 | 10:20am
Occurring Wednesdays at 4:30pm on Zoom.
Each month, a Bible story is explored through multimedia workshops: theatre, cooking, drama, and art.

Middle School Education | Grade 6-7 | 10:30am
Zoom meeting at 10:30am on Sundays during the pandemic.
The Sunday School program for this age engages Biblical narrative using storytelling (video), creative reflection and communal conversation.

High School Education | Grade 9-12 | 10:30am
Temporarily suspended during the pandemic.
Meets weekly in the Knewstub Parking Lot at noon on Sundays, weather permitting. Bring your own chair!

Opportunities to ***Grow Our Faith...***

The EDGE Youth Group | Grades 4-5
Meeting over Zoom; small gatherings in fall 2020 will take place as guidelines permit.
This is the first youth group experience for children. We build community beyond the Sunday School. We meet bi-monthly on Sundays at 11:30am.

Middle School Youth Group | Grades 6-8
Weekly meeting over Zoom; small gatherings in fall 2020 will take place as guidelines permit.
Youth in grade six through eight are welcome to join the Middle School Youth Group which meets every Wednesday from 7:00-8:00pm in the Youth Lounge (Chapel Lower Level).

High School Youth Group | Grades 4-5
Meeting over Zoom; small gatherings in fall 2020 will take place as guidelines permit.
Discuss the issues facing students and how God is at work in our day-to-day lives. We meet weekly for fellowship on Sundays from 7:00-8:30pm in the Youth Lounge as well as for big events throughout the fall and spring.

Confirmation | Grade 8
Confirmation may begin as guidelines permit. Small gatherings in fall 2020 will take place as guidelines permit.
Eighth graders commit themselves to a journey of learning more about the Christian faith and Episcopal tradition, and building relationships through mentoring and volunteering.

High School Breakfast | Grades 9-12
Students in grades 9-12 are welcome to join us on the second and fourth Fridays of each month for fellowship – our treat!

PASTORAL CARE

The vision and mission for Pastoral Care is to celebrate life's joys and bear one another's burdens and sorrows in fulfillment of God's command to love one another as God loves us. Opportunities to *Serve the Community...*

Caring Ministries

St. David's is a caring faith community with many ministries that support our members. Join us in making Christ's love known to others as part of the following ministries:

Birthday & Baptism Cards are sent to parishioners marking a celebration.

***Caring Meals** are delivered to parishioners identified by our clergy as needing support or encouragement.

Driving Angels drive parishioners to Church service or programs, and to other medical appointments.

Flower Ministry volunteers arrange and/or deliver Sunday and holiday flowers to homebound parishioners or those needing encouragement.

Needleworks Guild provide hand-knit caps, prayer shawls, prayer squares, and Baptismal blankets.

***St. David's Friends** are a group dedicated to those who are in need of companionship.

Stephen Ministry

Stephen Ministers are trained and supervised lay persons who provide on-to-one Christian care to individuals facing life challenges. A Stephen Minister is someone with a kind heart, open mind, and good listening ear. If you fit the description, please consider this valuable ministry.

*Walking the Mourner's Path

This non-denominational grief support program helps those who have lost a loved one transform their grief into joyful living. The course consists of 90-minute classes and runs for eight consecutive weeks. Each session has two facilitators plus a member of clergy present.

*Eucharistic Visitors

Trained and licensed volunteers share the sacrament of Holy Eucharist with parishioners who cannot be present with us at Sunday worship.

*Churchyard Neighbors

A group of women who have experienced the loss of a spouse, focusing on empowerment, resilience and inspiration. This group meets several times a year.

Phone Ministers

Almost eighty parishioners make a friendly phone call to members of the parish on a regular basis during the pandemic. In addition, they are able to facilitate volunteers to run essential errands as needed.

Prayer Companions

This is a prayer ministry in which fellow parishioners pray for our St. David's family and friends who are seeking God's grace, help, and blessings in all of life's circumstances. All prayer requests are held in confidence.

Seeking Hope

This group provides support, encouragement, education and faith to parents of addicted children. It meets the first Monday of the month at 6:00 pm online or in person.

#JourneyingForward

This bereavement support group for young adults meets the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month online or in person.

St. David's is a welcoming parish whose members are God-centered and infused with spiritual energy. We seek to meet the needs of all parishioners for Christian fellowship and encourage our members to participate in our community of faith.

Opportunities to *Grow with One Another...*

The Newcomer Ministry

Volunteers greet and welcome guests, as well as potential and new members of St. David's, orienting them to our community. During a traditional program year, Newcomer Dinners are held several times per year.

Women's Fellowship

This group provides opportunities for women to grow in their relationship with God and to support and encourage each other in their lives as Christian women. During a traditional program year, activities include: breakfasts, retreats, a weekly Bible study, on-site fellowship events and off-site trips such as Broadway shows and museum tours.

MATCH (Mothers and Their Children)

MATCH is a subgroup of Women's Fellowship for mothers. During a traditional program year, the group meets Wednesday afternoons for fellowship, prayer, conversation, and outreach projects.

Men's Fellowship

This group has a mission "to become fishers of men." They are dedicated to creating opportunities for men to develop vital friendships, personal integrity, and Christ-centered growth. During a traditional program year, activities include: monthly breakfasts, a weekly Bible study, special events such as retreats, and cookouts.

Epiphany Tree Burn

This is a bonfire held on Epiphany Sunday, where Christmas trees are collected around the community to be used in the bonfire. Hot cider and s'mores are offered.

Coffee Hour

Coffee and refreshments are provided after the 9:15am service. At this time, coffee hours are being held virtually. The Zoom link can be found below the church's livestream.

Breaking Bread Together: Small Group Suppers

This is a small group ministry in parishioners' homes where parishioners gather in intentional small groups to share a meal, conversation, and fellowship. This ministry is on hold at this point due to social distancing guidelines.

Social Singles

All singles, 40+ years of age, gather for activities such as: dinners, picnics, game nights, trips and more. On Sunday evenings, this group meets for Bridge.

Supper Club Fellowship

The Supper Club brings parishioners together several times a year to enjoy food, fellowship and a chance to meet new friends. This ministry is on hold at this point due to social distancing guidelines.

Young Adults Group (20's & 30's)

This group gathers for fellowship and outreach projects once per month. Open to all 20s, 30s, or young at heart!

Wine & Dine Fellowship

Members meet in parishioners homes for Christian fellowship, a meal, and home Eucharist, shared together in a relaxed setting. This ministry is on hold at this point due to social distancing guidelines.

The St. David's Country Fair & Auction

The Fair the oldest continuous church fair in the country, draws parishioners and neighbors from surrounding communities and the Philadelphia area to share a day of fun, food and festivities. This year, the fair will not be held in the same we have in past years but there will be two opportunities to celebrate and raise funds for Outreach. First, there will be a drive-through Fair with pop-up tents showing all of our Outreach partnerships and ministries. Second, the "UnFair" will be an in-house silent auction within St. David's membership and a one-hour live auction with cocktail/mocktail party. All proceeds go to support our local and international outreach and is a ministry to the entire community.



FINANCE & STEWARDSHIP

The Finance Commission oversees all of our financial resources for the mission and ministry of St. David's Church including the annual Budget, the graveyard, the endowments, and the legacy society (1715 Society). The membership includes Vestry and members of St. David's with particular financial skills, all committed to being good stewards of the resources God has given us.

The Stewardship Commission is the holy management of our shared resources, an opportunity for us to share our time, talents and treasures with one another in the service of God. The year-round efforts of the Stewardship Commission help further educate parishioners about how to best to employ our gifts in the service of our common life— be they financial, organizational, or spiritual. The Stewardship Commission organizes an annual fundraising campaign for the mission and upkeep of St. David's.

Giving creates a sense of ownership and obligation—both to God and to one another. The journey of faith is very much linked with the giving of oneself. Just as we follow a Christ who gave of himself for us, we hope to model that selflessness in our own giving.

PROPERTY

The mission of the Property Commission is to protect and enhance the physical assets of the church and to ensure that those assets are passed on to future generations.

Our worship, education, and fellowship spaces exist on 39 acres, which also include the St. David's Graveyard. The Property Commission is tasked with the responsibility of identifying and prioritizing Long-Range and Capital Projects that guarantee the continued use of the grounds and buildings, which help to support the mission and ministry of the church well into coming generations.

Opportunities to *Serve the Property...*

The St. David's Parish History and Archives Committee

The Archives Committee collects, preserves and displays our archival materials, past and present, which enables us to honor the St. David's heritage and our story, thus making Christ known to others.

The programs of The Parish History and Archives Committee are now focused on the following activities.

- Cataloging the extensive collection of documents which include Vestry minutes, copies of The Record, subsequently renamed The Dove, architectural drawings of the Church, the Harrison Parish House, the 1956 Chapel and the present Chapel
- Writing articles for the "Archives Corner" in the Dove
- Publishing events of the past such as the controversy over the building the 1956 Chapel, and a campaign by a parishioner to advocate for universal suffrage
- Rotating the display in the hallway leading to St. David's Hall highlighting illustrious parishioners and events that have occurred
- Planning the Summer Lecture Series on a variety of topics

The St. David's Pantry Patch

The St. David's Pantry Patch was created in the spring of 2012 as a senior internship project by Bailey Kimmel. Relationships with local community centers and parishes were established and grants were acquired from local nonprofits and diocesan funds. A corner section in the greater Saint David's Community garden was allocated for the purpose of growing and caring for fresh produce exclusively intended for local soup kitchens and parish feeding ministries. Nine raised boxes were created by Fritz Fischer as an Eagle Scout final project and donated to the Pantry Patch. Dirt and compost were donated from local garden shops, and plants were purchased with the help of grants.

The following year several other Eagle Scouts created a new Deer Proof fence to surround the entire community garden and decrease the amount of damage caused each year. In 2020, new boxes were made by the Kimmel and Farrow families and an energetic group of volunteers tends the Pantry Patch, which is currently partnered with the Ardmore Food Pantry, run out of St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Ardmore.

The St. David's Campus Care Corps

This group waters and maintains the various potted flowers and plants throughout our buildings and grounds.



COMMUNICATIONS

The Communications Commission, formed in Fall 2018, oversees the dissemination of news and information related to St. David's and its ministries, events, and parish life. The goal is to provide effective communications both internally, within the St. David's community and externally within Radnor, surrounding communities, Philadelphia and the Diocese, to help advance the church's mission to know God in Jesus Christ and make Christ known to others. The overall "umbrella" message conveyed is St. David's is a welcoming parish and that ALL are invited to share in the community.

Public Relations

ST. DAVID’S EPISCOPAL DAY SCHOOL

St. David’s Episcopal Day School is a faith-centered school that offers exceptional education, enrichment, and extracurricular programming for children ages 18 months through kindergarten. Highlights of SDEDS include weekly chapel, character development, Christian-values curriculum, small-class sizes, a state-of-the-art playground, inclusive allergy policies, extracurricular activities, and specialists on staff. SDEDS is committed to diversity, inclusion, and affordability for all and offers a tuition assistance program for qualifying families.

Curriculum *at the Day School...*

Our curriculum is grounded in Christian values and aimed at nurturing whole-child development through self-directed, hands-on learning activities. SDEDS values process over product and embraces innovative thinking while celebrating the joy and wonder of childhood. Through the school’s curriculum, children engage in interactive lessons and activities that foster growth in social, emotional, physical, spiritual and intellectual development in language arts, mathematics, social studies, and science. Our programs are enhanced by extracurricular activities that include: library, art, music, Spanish, outdoor learning, and physical education. Students participate in a weekly chapel service.

Extended Day *at the Day School...*

Enrichment Clubs

Our enrichment programs are a wonderful way for students to study a topic in more depth. Teachers who have a talent or expertise in a specific area lead the programs.

Speech & Language

Our kindergarten offers a challenging, nurturing, and motivating environment where students can grow and mature intellectually, emotionally, socially, physically and spiritually. Students participate in mathematics, science, social studies, and language arts.

Programs *at the Day School...*

Parent/Child

This program is designed to encourage whole-child development through play, socialization, and interactive circle activities, all with the comfort of a trusted adult nearby.
