Kings in 1 and 2 Kings: Northern and Southern Kingdoms

Southern Kingdom (Judah) - Capital: Jerusalem

The Southern Kingdom maintained the Davidic line, so succession was mostly dynastic (father to son), though there were exceptions.

- 1. **Rehoboam** Son of Solomon; kingdom splits under his reign.
- 2. Abijam (Abijah) Son of Rehoboam; continues Davidic line.
- 3. **Asa** Son of Abijam; religious reformer.
- 4. Jehoshaphat Son of Asa; alliance with Israel.
- 5. **Jehoram (Joram)** Son of Jehoshaphat; married Ahab's daughter.
- 6. Ahaziah Son of Jehoram; short reign.
- 7. Athaliah (Queen) Mother of Ahaziah; seized power (non-Davidic).
- 8. Joash (Jehoash) Son of Ahaziah; crowned as child, temple reform.
- 9. **Amaziah** Son of Joash; defeated by Israel.
- 10. Azariah (Uzziah) Son of Amaziah; struck with leprosy.
- 11. **Jotham** Son of Azariah; good reign.
- 12. Ahaz Son of Jotham: idolatrous.
- 13. Hezekiah Son of Ahaz; major reformer.
- 14. **Manasseh** Son of Hezekiah; long, idolatrous reign.
- 15. **Amon** Son of Manasseh; assassinated.
- 16. **Josiah** Son of Amon; major reformer.
- 17. Jehoahaz Son of Josiah; deposed by Egypt.
- 18. **Jehoiakim** Brother of Jehoahaz; puppet of Egypt/Babylon.
- 19. **Jehoiachin** Son of Jehoiakim; exiled to Babylon.
- 20. **Zedekiah** Uncle of Jehoiachin; last king before Babylonian destruction.



Northern Kingdom (Israel) - Capital: Samaria

Succession was frequently non-dynastic. Many kings rose by assassination or coups. High instability.

- 1. **Jeroboam I** Appointed by people; leads secession.
- 2. Nadab Son of Jeroboam; killed by Baasha.
- 3. **Baasha** Usurper; kills Jeroboam's line.
- 4. Elah Son of Baasha; killed by Zimri.
- 5. **Zimri** Military coup; reigns 7 days.
- 6. Omri General; power struggle; founds strong dynasty.
- 7. Ahab Son of Omri; infamous, marries Jezebel.
- 8. Ahaziah Son of Ahab; dies without heir.
- 9. **Jehoram (Joram)** Brother of Ahaziah; killed by Jehu.
- 10. Jehu Military coup; ends Ahab's line.
- 11. Jehoahaz Son of Jehu; oppressed by Syria.
- 12. Jehoash (Joash) Son of Jehoahaz; fought Judah.
- 13. **Jeroboam II** Son of Jehoash; prosperity.
- 14. **Zechariah** Son of Jeroboam II; killed by Shallum.
- 15. **Shallum** Coup; reigns 1 month.
- 16. **Menahem** Military coup; brutal, pays tribute.
- 17. **Pekahiah** Son of Menahem; killed by Pekah.
- 18. Pekah Usurper; killed by Hoshea.
- 19. Hoshea Last king; rebelled, led to exile.
