Leslie Lewis moved to approve the minutes from the 2024 Annual Meeting. Molly Zonino seconded. Passed unanimously.

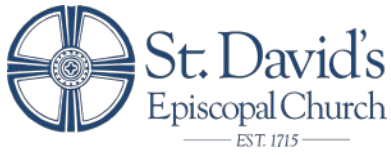
Elections
